Lots of people liked Jesus. When He rode into the city lots of people were full of joy.



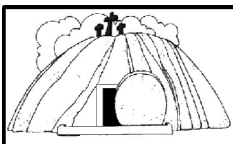
Jesus knew he had many enemies too. At supper He told His friends that they would kill Him.
