How to Contact Staff

Good communication between home and school is important and there are many ways to contact staff if there is something important you need to tell us.

In the morning: The best way of letting teachers know something is in the morning, or when the teachers are outside or at the class door. If it is a longer conversation then in the evening straight after school is best, just speak to your child's class teacher to arrange the best evening.

Email: You can email any of the teachers if you are not around at the start or end of the day. Teachers cannot read or respond to emails though between 5:30pm and 8:00am the next morning or at weekends. We aim to respond to all emails within a few days.

School Office: You can phone the school office and leave messages for teachers, such as if there is a change in who is picking up your child or if you would like to make an appointment to see a teacher. You can also email adminoffice@bordon-inf.hants.sch.uk for anything non urgent.

Special Education Needs: Mrs Brown is the SENCo at both Bordon Infants and Bordon Juniors so if you have concerns about your child or need to discuss anything about your child's additional provision at school she is the person to contact. Please ring or email the school office and she will get back to you.
